Tim Guffey mentioned that if you own a Classic / Collector vehicle or plan on building one be aware the House and Senate have passed SSB 5127 and will be sending it to the Governor to sign! This bill changes the requirements to register your Collector Vehicle with Collector Plates by adding a requirement for you to PROVE you have another vehicle for daily transportation AND have Collector Vehicle insurance for the vehicle you are wanting to register to a DOL agent. The DOL will also be sending out a survey form to all 300,000 currently registered Collector Vehicle owners in Washing State requesting the Status of your vehicle and whether they are insured. If you Do NOT respond to them within 45 Days they will DE-REGISTER YOUR VEHICLES ! This new requirement will go into effect January 15th 2026.

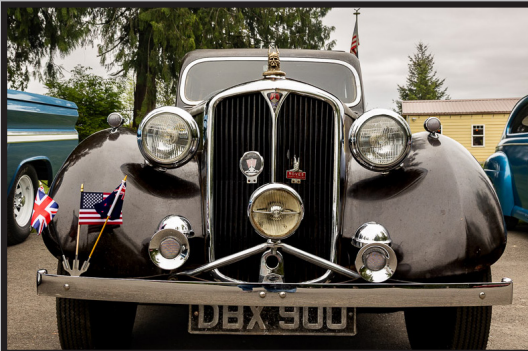
